Limousin
A centuries-old beef breed from the limousin region of France, the small-boned, large cattle have long been known as "the butcher's breed" in their home country, first topping carcass competition in 1857. Imported to the United States in the early 1970s, Limousin cattle are noted for their ability to withstand cold weather, rapid weight gain, and exceptional carcass grade and cutout.

Brahman

A truly American Breed developed in the United States in the late 1800s and early 1900s from bos indicus cattle from India, Brahman cattle are noted for their ability to withstand heat and humidity, adaptability to different environment, easy calving, longevity resistance to insects and disease - which means fewer vet visits - and efficiency in converting all types of pasture to lean, healthy beef.
